Confession of Sin

Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another. Most holy and merciful God, we confess to you and before the whole company of heaven, that we have sinned by our own fault, in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.

O LORD, open our lips, and our mouths will declare your praise. For you have no delight in sacrifice; if we were to give a burnt offering, you would not be pleased.
